# TOPIC 2.4.1

## RECEIVING YOUR HEALING



### OBJECTIVES OF THIS LESSON:

- To understand that God wants you healed (I wish above all, healing is a finished work through Christ and its gift to you).
- To know how to receive our Healing by faith.
- To teach us about the role of confession when it comes to healing.
- To appreciate the role of our mind towards healing.

### 1. GOD WANTS YOU HEALED (I WISH ABOVE ALL)

#### Isaiah 53:4-5

*"Surely, he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed."*

#### 3 John 2

*"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."*

It is God's perfect will for us to walk in divine healing and we must know beyond a shadow of a doubt that Jesus died that we should be restored in all areas of our lives. Healing is part of the Salvation package. The word Salvation is the Greek word "Sozo", it appears 111 times and it means to keep safe, to Heal and to be delivered.

God does not only want us to be healed physically but wants us to be healed in all areas of our lives, that is in our mind, in our emotions, in our relationships, in our careers and in our finances.

### 2. RECEIVING OUR HEALING BY FAITH

#### James 5:15

*"and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him."*

#### Matthew 9:22

*"But Jesus turning and seeing her said, "Daughter, take courage; your faith has made you well." At once the woman was made well."*

#### Matthew 9:29

*"Then He touched their eyes, saying, "It shall be done to you according to your faith."*

It takes faith in God's promises through Jesus for us to receive and maintain our healing. You must believe you have received and not be moved by what you feel.

### 3. THE ROLE OF CONFESSION AND OUR HEALING.

#### Isaiah 33:24

*"And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity."*

**Proverbs 18:21**

*"The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit."*

**Ezekiel 37:4-6**

*"Then he said to me, 'Prophecy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! This is what the Sovereign Lord says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life. I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I am the Lord.'"*

**Hebrews 4:14 (AMP)**

*Inasmuch then as we [believers] have a great High Priest who has [already ascended and] passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession [of faith and cling tenaciously to our absolute trust in Him as Savior]*

The word Confession, "Homología", literally means 'speaking the same way', which describes, in Greek colloquial language, simple oral consent or agreement.

**4. THE ROLE OF OUR MIND TOWARDS HEALING**

**Proverbs 16:24**

*"Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones."*

**Philippians 4:8**

*"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things."*

Feeding on negative things can be a hindrance to obtaining our total healing. It is important to meditate on the promises of God in order to shape your attitude toward obtaining your healing and maintaining it.
